



CARS Media Accreditation

CARS has established a Media Accreditation process for the Canadian Rally Championship. Registration for accreditation is welcomed from media organizations as well as individuals who work within the media industry.

All requests for media accreditation will be reviewed by CARS for authenticity and CARS reserves the right to deny accreditation requests that do not meet acceptance criteria.

Applicants should complete the attached form and submit it to: Terry Epp, National Series Manager (crc@carsrally.ca).

A response to your application will be made by email. Please include an email address and phone number where you can be reached.

Once accredited, media should also register with events ahead of time indicating that you are CARS accredited media and giving your bib number. At the event you should complete event registration and sign the event waiver.

For media without a CARS media vest, a media vest will be provided at that time. (This media vest must be returned to the event HQ at the conclusion of the event)

Guidelines for Accredited Media

At Canadian Rally Championship Events

Media Accreditation:

Media accreditation is restricted to working members of the media only and is not extendable to others accompanying them (including helpers, family and friends).

Media Bib:

- a) The media bib is the property of CARS (and returned to the event HQ at the conclusion of each event unless alternative arrangements are given by the Series Manager).
- b) The bib must be worn at all times when in a stage or working at event venues without exception (service parks, podium, start/finish locations).
- c) The bib must be worn by the registered media person

Media Access Level:

- a) Level 1 CRC Series** - For media following the CRC Series (attending 4 or more events) and wish Stage access. Level 1 media must submit their proposed movement plans to the event's Clerk of the Course by 18h00 the evening before the start of the event for approval.
- b) Level 2 Event Media** - For media attending 3 or fewer events in the series. (Stage access will be limited to the officials/media zones at Official Spectator Areas or Official Media zones (as/if such zones are made available by the event)).

Safety Guidelines:

Entry to stages is controlled by rally officials and access to stages is prohibited after the passage of Course Car 00 which is usually 30-40 minutes before the scheduled time of the first car on the stage. (This lead time can be longer than this when the stage is longer in length.)

Tape Colours:

Green and White	Spectator areas (also open to media)
Yellow and Black	Rally marshals and media
Red and White	Restricted zone and not open even to media

Please note that in areas with no tape being displayed, care must be taken to avoid any location, which would be taped with red and white coloured tape if tape had been used.

Championship: The official title of the 7 round series is: **The Canadian Rally Championship presented by Subaru.**
