SAFETY PLAN TEMPLATE

ASN Rate Code: R1 – one day national
R2 – two day national
R3 – one day regional

The National/Regional Rally Safety Plan Template is a requirement for the issue of a CARS permit as per 4.2.2.1 (or 4.2.2.2, as applicable). This template is meant to serve as the Safety Plan's Table of Contents as well as providing guidance on the form and substance of the contents of the plan.

PART A: Organizational Information

- A-1 Name of Organizing Club
- A-2 Date(s) of proposed event
- A-3 Name of Event Officials (as per CARS 6.1) and their contact info (Cell, Home Phone and Email):
 - Organizer/Coordinator
 - Clerk of the Course
 - Chief Control Marshal
 - Chief of Security (Safety Officer)
 - Chief Scrutineer
 - Chief Radio Marshal
 - other
- A-4 Description of event communications set-up
 - Location of net radio control
 - Type: amateur radio/commercial radio/combination)
 - Brief description of official and competitor vehicle tracking plans
 - Brief description of operations plans
- A-5 Description of safety requirements for both entrant and marshal participants (waivers, wrist bands, event identification, etc.). Please note: All event marshals and officials should wear CARS marshal vests when in stages/restricted areas at all times.



PART B: Stage Details

- B-1** For each stage in a rally or configuration of a stage (not including opposite direction over the same road/roads), the following details are required:
- a) Stage number(s)/Name(s)
 - b) Stage distance (start line to flying finish line)
 - c) Stage surface base (gravel/dirt, pavement and percentage if pavement)
 - d) Stage history (number of years used, fastest average speed attained)
 - e) Name of Stage Captain/Commander
 - f) Name of Assistant Stage Captain/Commander
 - g) Road ownership
 - h) Permission granted by (name of person responsible)
 - i) Number/Location of:
 - i. Official Spectator Areas
 - ii. Unofficial Spectator Areas
 - j) Number/Location of Stage Marshals:
 - i. Timing (start and finish)
 - ii. Radio
 - iii. Traffic Control (Security) at start, finish, interior
 - iv. Spectator (Security)

B-2 Stage Preparation Schematics

These schematics would be used by stage preparation crews, Stage Captains and the Assistant Stage Captains, official vehicles or official to either prepare the stage or to verify the stage's preparation.

- a) For each stage, either 'i' or 'ii' or both:
 - i) A straight line 'map' schematic of the stage showing each junction with a road, driveway, trail or pathway and giving its distance from the start of the stage and its method of security: tape-T; tape and signage-T/S, access barriers-B (such as marshal vehicle, cones, portable barriers, etc.) and other information such as: TC (Traffic Control) numbers, names of residents/owners and their contact info, etc.
See Stage Security Example A)
 - ii) A detail chart/spreadsheet of the stage showing the above information (see Stage Security Example B)
 - iii) For a detail map of Middle Hastings see Example C.



Note:

- i) GPS co-ordinates are required for: the stage start control, the start line, the flying finish, the stage finish stop control and for all in-stage radio and security/traffic control marshal locations.
 - ii) Both examples outline the security details from the Middle Hastings stage from the 2015 Rally of the Tall Pines.
- b) Brief description of how access to the stage start and finish by vehicles and spectators will be controlled by the security marshals (including physical barriers)
 - c) Detailed diagram for each official spectator area which follows the CARS Taping Guidelines and an outline for spectator access, management and parking.
 - d) A detailed diagram for each unofficial spectator area which outlines set-up requirements as well as an outline for spectator access, management and parking.

Part C: Emergency Plan Details

- C-1 Protocols for a participant incident/stage stoppage
- C-2 An outline of event plans for: a) medical services, b) medical services transportation and c) placement/moving of medical services during event
- C-3 Procedure for serious incidents including a) how and who communicates with emergency responders, b) procedures to ensure emergency responders reach the incident site, c) how and who communicates for the event with media and other interested parties

Part D: Maps

- D-1 Map(s) of the rally showing the stages and their starts and finishes. (Can be overall or by day or legs or a combination)
- D-2 Separate map for each stage showing start, finish, radio and marshal locations



Part E: Other Event Documentation

If the event has other documentation directly related to safety planning, then those documents should be part of the safety plan (example: The use of Alert Points, etc.).

Part F: Protocols

The entire safety package is to be supplied to the NSM, the stewards, official vehicles and members of the organizing committee including the Chief of Security (Safety Officer).

At minimum, the Following parts of the safety plan should be given to the stage preparation crews and the Stage Captain and Assistant Stage Captain: Parts A, B, C, D-2 and E (if applicable).

Note: If some information is unavailable before submission deadlines, then that information should be given to the NSM and stewards before the start of the event.

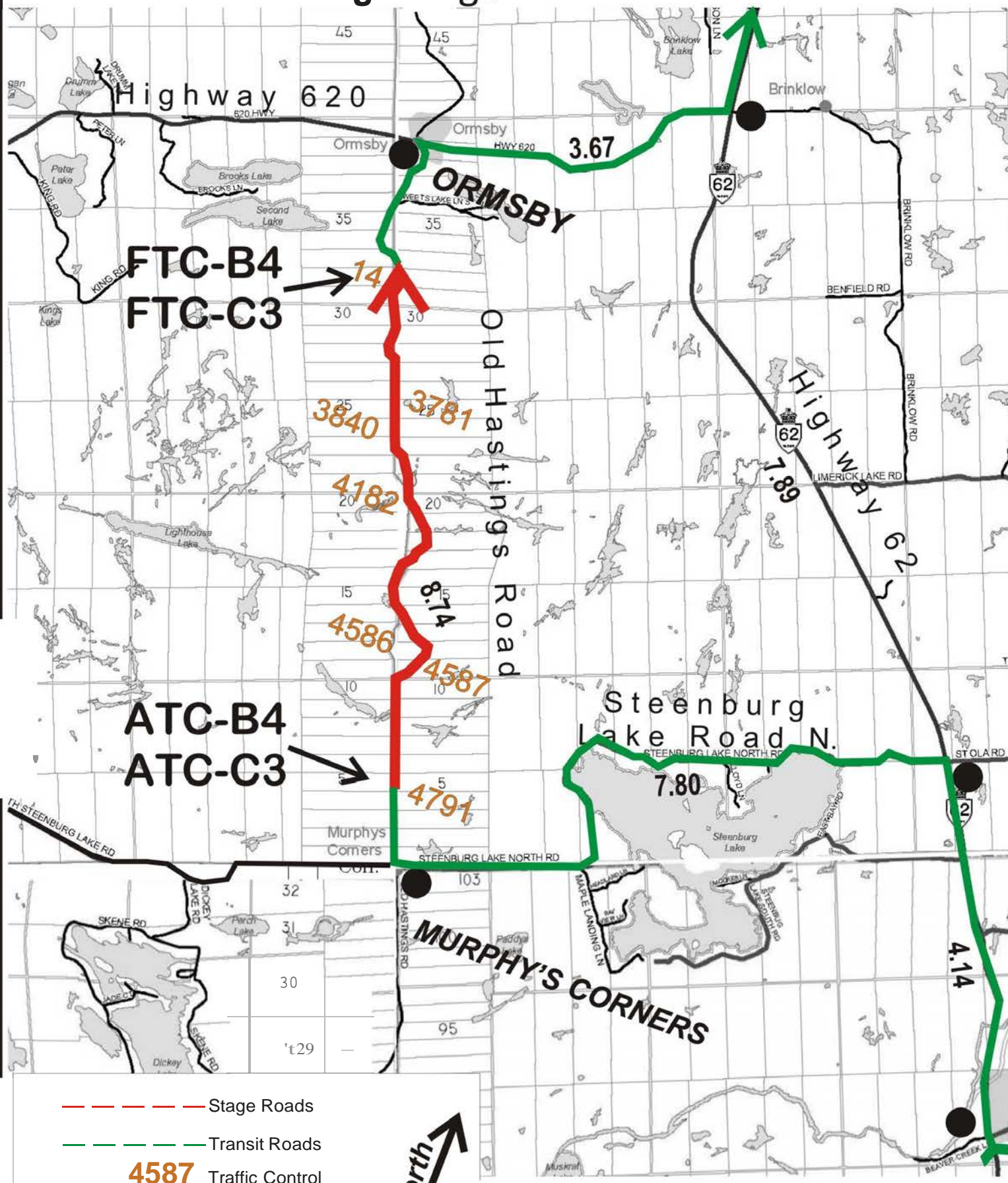
