

## CARS Competition Vehicle Number reservation policy

CARS has chosen adopt fixed car numbers; this policy is effective May 1st 2024.

Each competitor intending to enter a competition vehicle in a CARS sanctioned event will be required to reserve a car number as per this **CARS competition vehicle number reservation policy.** 

- 1. Numbers 1 10 will be reserved for use by CARS.
- 2. Number 1 will be offered to the overall champion from the previous season.
- 3. Number 2 will be offered to the overall 2WD champion from the previous season.
- 4. Cars numbers 1 & 2 will keep their regularly reserved number while using 1 or 2.
- 5. Numbers 3 10 will be used by CARS to accommodate special situations, while limiting the use of single digit numbers.
- 6. Numbers 0, 00, 000, 998 & 999 are reserved by CARS for the various course cars.
- 7. Number 911 will not be used to avoid radio confusion.
- 8. Numbers may be retired at CARS discretion (e.g. #43 to align with ARA in honoring Ken Block)

## **Competition Vehicle Number reservation policy:**

- 1. The general rule is that a licensed competitor will be eligible to reserve a number at no cost when purchasing a CARS license.
- 2. The competitor will keep that number for as long as they are a current CARS license holder (National, Regional, Single event or International permit) plus 1-year grace period.
- 3. In order to keep a car number while not being a current CARS license holder & after the 1-year grace period, or as a previous license holder that wants to reserve a number for future use, a competitor will pay a fee of \$100 plus taxes per year.
- 4. Numbers that are not reserved will become available for new license holders.
- 5. As with licenses the car number reservation process follows the calendar year.
- 6. The CARS office will manage the ongoing number reservation process by;
  - a. Displaying the current available numbers on the CARS website.
  - b. Assigning requested numbers to license holders.
