Application for use of drone at CARS sanctioned events



The use of any Drone regardless of size, at CARS sanctioned events is restricted to those in possession of a Special Flight Operations Certificate (SFOC) for the event.

In order to obtain an SFOC the “drone use at CARS sanctioned event” application form granting permission to operate at the event and any landowner permissions must accompany the Transport Canada SFOC application.

Upon presentation of your SFOC to the CARS Regional Director and event organizer for their final approval, you will be eligible to fly your Drone at the event in accordance with the agreed to flight plan. Priority use of airspace will be given to CARS media.

All drone operators are to carry liability coverage of not less than five million dollars. The Canadian Association of Rallysport and the Event are to be named as additional insured on the certificate.

Approval Requirements:

1. Complete this application form and gain provisional approval from the event organizer for specific flight plan.
2. Gain landowner permissions to operate over private land (if applicable).
3. Obtain Transport Canada Special Flight Operations Certificate. (TC website says it can take up to 30 days)
4. Present to the CARS Regional Director and event organiser for final approval to operate at the event, your;
 - a. Special Flight Operations Certificate,
 - b. Transport Canada Operators License,
 - c. Insurance Certificate
 - d. Flight plan.
5. Once you have final approval you are eligible to operate at the CARS sanctioned event in accordance with the following operating rules.

Operating rules:

1. Follow your approved flight plan.
2. Do Not operate directly over service parks, ceremonial starts, parc expose, parc ferme, podiums, spectators.
3. Do not operate in front of competition vehicles while on stage.
4. The operator must remain in visual contact with the drone.
5. Do not operate over private property without pre-approval of the landowner.
