Tool for recognizing a possible concussion

This tool does not determine whether a person has a concussion or not. It simply exists to help to increase suspicion of potential brain injury.

If there was **any** period of loss of consciousness during the crash, individual should be seen by event medical staff.

If individual has any neck pain, do not remove helmet unless trained to do so. They should be seen by event medical staff.

Are they alert and oriented? Delay in giving answer counts as incorrect answer
