	<ul> <li>The "Revenue Neutral" insurance fund has reached its target goal for a float, and that may help to stabilize insurance rates for 2024 if the broker does not increase the rates too much in March.</li> </ul>

Currently at final draft and almost ready to go out for two-week review.</li> <li>Create a rule change that will prevent teams from leaving the prescribed route on transits to possibly perform illegal service, while still applying a reasonable amount of discretion for road conditions etc.</li> </ul>
