13	Technical Director Last cage specs update from FIA was 2020 (253 appendix J), we expect updated cage specs in 2027. Is it time to update the CARS cage specs to the 2020 base for all national entered vehicles? Extensive discussion ensued. Discussion on turbo restrictor verification. Historical car being built with a FIA-spec Custom Cages kit. Car/cage will meet FIA historic homologation specifications. Board approved the following: Create wording to allow FIA homologated cages, specifically for new build, historical vehicles within the CRC. Wording to be sent to board for inclusion into the rules via email ASAP.
