Subject: Soliciting expression of interest for CARS National Scrutineer role

The volunteer position of CARS National Scrutineer is appointed by the CARS board for a 2-year term.

The CARS National Scrutineer reports to the CARS Technical Director, we would prefer an individual that can attend all 8 national events but will consider splitting the role into two to reduce workload. A bi-lingual candidate is preferred.

The National Scrutineer will represent the CARS technical position and support consistent interpretation and application of the technical rules. The CARS National Scrutineer will support the event Chief Scrutineer and his team by providing guidance and assistance with the scrutineering process, technical rules interpretation, class interpretation and compliance.

The National Scrutineer is a CARS official at events and is required to work with a high degree of professionalism, respect competitor's privacy, confidentiality of issues under investigation and findings.

The CARS National Scrutineer with input from the Technical Director should establish CARS specific technical items to be reviewed, monitored or inspected while at each of the events. This is intended to increase consistent application of and compliance with the rules across the series.
