Subject: CARS Competition License Renewals for 2021

Issue Date: March 3, 2021

Effective Date: Immediately

Background:

The license renewal procedure requires competitors to renew First Aid training qualifications as well as perhaps to obtain a Medical Examination. Both of these activities are contrary to the intent of the COVID prevention guidelines in most jurisdictions in Canada, and are activities that carry risk of exposure. CARS does not wish to place competitors into this position unless absolutely necessary.

2021 Licensing:

For the 2021 license holding year, competition license renewals will be accepted up to June 30th without the renewal of expired First Aid certification and/or Medical Examination.

The requirements pertaining to First Aid and Medical Examination therefore become:

- First Aid Certificates that expired in 2020 or during 2021 will continue to be accepted for license renewal for 2021 competition year licenses.
- In the case where a Medical Examination is required for 2021, an acceptable Medical Self Declaration form must accompany the application.
- The above exemptions apply ONLY to license holders that held valid CARS licenses for 2020 i.e renewals only.
- New license applicants will be required to submit the full and current First Aid and Medical fitness documents.
- This exemption does not apply to those competitors that intend to apply for an International license.
