Subject: Annual Electronic Waiver for CARS Performance Rallies

Implementation:

- 1. Immediately for Competitors. (except Quebec)
- 2. By May 1st for volunteers (except Quebec)
- 3. TBA for Quebec competitors & volunteers

CARS plan to start using annual electronic waivers for all performance rallies.

Website Registration and Annual waiver will be required for the following individuals.

- 1. Competitors
- 2. Volunteers
 - a. Service Crew
 - b. CARS officials
 - c. Event officials
 - d. Stewards
 - e. Event Volunteers
 - f. Media

Competitors.

- 1. The competitor must sign the waiver in the language of preference indicated on their license application.
- 2. A link to the annual waiver will be available on the CARS website under "Documents" "Insurance".
- 3. Follow the waiver link and complete the annual waiver application.
- 4. Your annual waiver will be available on your phone.
- 5. Keep a screen shot for easy retrieval at events as it will be checked at registration.
- 6. Registration of the waiver will be recorded on your license profile

All Volunteers (as listed in point 2)

- All volunteers are required to register on the CARS website. https://carsrally.ca/wp-login.php Complete your profile and check all the volunteer roles that apply to you.
- 2. If you are already registered as a different role, send an email to office@carsrally.ca and request addition of volunteer role, it will be added by the CARS office.
- 3. Once you are registered on the website the CARS office will assign a volunteer license number that will allow for tracking that the waiver has been signed and is valid, this information will be shared with events that you are volunteering with.
- 4. A link to the annual waiver will be available on the CARS website under "Documents" "Insurance".
- 5. Follow the link and complete the annual waiver application.
- 6. Your annual waiver will be available on your phone.
- 7. Keep a screen shot for easy retrieval at events as it will be checked at registration.
- 8. Volunteers must sign the waiver in the language they are most comfortable in and understand

Currently the insurance company does not have the use of an annual electronic waiver in Quebec. Quebec competitors and volunteers will be required to sign the paper waiver at each event they attend across Canada. Competitors and volunteers, from outside Quebec, may present their Annual CARS waiver as proof of waiver.
