

PIRELLI SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM FACT SHEET

This Fact Sheet provides additional details and highlights key benefits and responsibilities to the effected parties in the CRC under CARS Announcement 2025-07 released May 27, 2025.

Summary of Benefits for the CRC Series, Events and Competitors

Benefits to the CRC series

- Maintains series integrity by improving the financial viability of CRC events.
- Helps maintain attractiveness of the CRC as a platform for other sponsors.

Benefits to Events in the CRC

- A cash payment will be made directly to each of the eight Events in the CRC. Each
 payment is to be received by the event a minimum of two weeks before the Events'
 competition starting dates.
- This financial support will help with the Event Organizers' costs, from materials to enhanced support in managing and caring for volunteers.
- The presence of a major series sponsor elevates the prestige of the CRC Events in the eyes of spectators, local public, media and other local sponsors.

Benefits to CRC National Competitors

- Year-end cash awards if the annual volume of Pirelli tires sold exceeds 200: Pirelli will
 pay \$40 per tire sold above a minimum of 200 into a prize fund. Distribution and value of
 the prize fund depends on the number of tires sold, which will be tracked by Pirelli's
 authorized dealers.
- Improved finances of events in the CRC helps to offset inflation and elevate the competition experience while maintaining series integrity.
- Presence of a major sponsor elevates the prestige of the series in the eyes of other sponsors.

Summary of CRC Series Communications Responsibilities

- Pirelli is to be designated as "an official sponsor of the Canadian Rally Championship"
- Pirelli's support is to be prominently displayed on all media assets of the Canadian Rally Championship, including websites and social media.
- CRC shall use its reasonable best efforts to prevent any competitors of Pirelli from engaging in promotions, advertising, or other practices <u>not already in effect</u> at some CRC events* that claim an affiliation or endorsement from the CRC.
 - *Exemption: Nokian Tyres is a pre-existing sponsor of the Rallye Perce Neige.

Summary of CRC Organizers Responsibilities at Events

- a. Communicate the Event's contact name for benefits to the Pirelli program coordinator.
- b. Work with the Pirelli program coordinator to receive podium caps, banners and arch.
- c. Apply the Pirelli logo to event website, virtual documents and printed materials.
- d. Verify during Scrutineering (Technical Inspection):
 - the presence of Pirelli decals on Nationally entered vehicles, and
 - that Pirelli tires are correctly used per (c.) below (Open 4WD SF 85+/FIA homologation), otherwise assess a \$250 fee (beginning at Baie de Chaleurs)
- e. Install and move Pirelli banners and arches on stages and at start/finish podium.
- f. Ensure Pirelli badges are temporarily applied to the driving suits and Pirelli caps are awarded and worn by crews on the Overall and Open 2WD podiums.

Summary of Obligations for CRC National Competitors

- a. National competitors are required to display four Pirelli decals, one on each corner of their vehicles.
- b. Competing national crews are required to temporarily apply Pirelli badges to their driving suits during podium ceremonies.
- c. Pirelli will be the exclusive* tire used on competing vehicles in these CRC classes:
 - Vehicles that comply with their original FIA homologation requirements
 - Open 4WD vehicles driven by a competitor with a Speed Factor rating of 85+ Starting with the Rallye Baie des Chaleurs, a fee of \$250 CAD will be assessed for vehicles running other tire makes in the exclusive classes. This fee will be collected by the CRC and is payable to Pirelli.

*Except for the CRC winter rallies: Rallye Perce Neige and Big White Winter Rally
